President's Message

These are very exciting times for the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce. We have had seven years of increased revenues due to new and renewing membership rates, added events and additional profits from existing events. We are also having to move our offices as our current lease is expiring.

The very exciting news is that, after more than 25 years, the Pasadena Chamber is purchasing a modest building at 44 North Mentor Avenue for our headquarters. We were very lucky to find an affordable building and very favorable financing so that the monthly payments on the building would be about equal to what renting a comparable space in today's market. We may also have the opportunity to generate some revenue from portions of the building, as well.

As I said, we got very lucky.

We are also very fortunate to have had help from Chamber members and our Board of Directors. Chris Robertson of **Robertson Commercial** acted as our broker to help locate, then negotiate a fair price for the property. We were able to make a competitive offer and secure the funding necessary thanks to our friends and loyal Chamber members at **IUOE**, **Local 12** who see the Pasadena Chamber as a good investment.

The Chamber Board appointed an ad hoc committee to oversee any acquisition or relocation. These individuals, George Falardeau, CL Keedy and Ben Green, with enthusiastic assistance from Patty Waggoner, made the acquisition possible. George helped develop our relationship with Chris Robertson. Patty worked hard to help identify a site and then arranged the funding deal for us and even helped identify a contractor member, **Syntax Builders**, to do some of the required improvements.

We are very excited at the prospect of moving in somewhat larger space. I am very grateful for the help and support of so many Chamber members and friends who made this happen for the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce.


