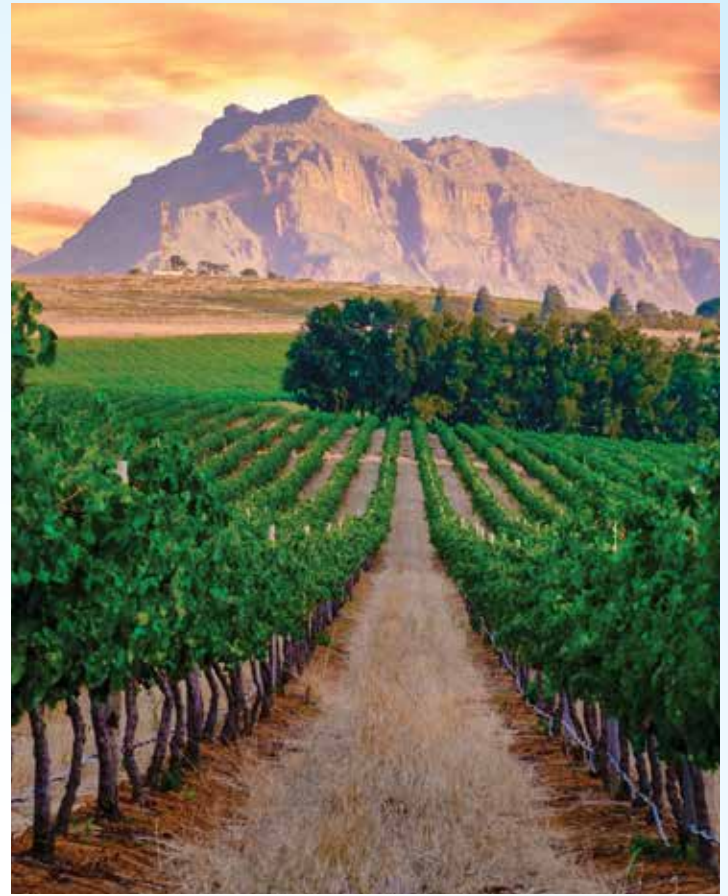
DAY 1: THU LOS ANGELES – JOHANNESBURG

Arrive in time at LAX International Airport for your overnight flight to Johannesburg. Enjoy inflight meals and services.

DAY 2: FRI JOHANNESBURG ARRIVAL

Welcome to South Africa! Upon arrival at Johannesburg Airport, you will be met by a representative and transferred to your hotel for check-in. Spend the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Johannesburg





DAY 3: SAT JOHANNESBURG – KRUGER NATIONAL PARK (B/-/D)

This morning you will embark on an orientation tour of Soweto. SOWETO, an acronym for Southwestern Township, is home to over 2 million people. Despite living in crowded and chaotic conditions, these citizens share a tangible sense of community, which the ordered, walled, and northern suburbs lack. Drive past the Hector Pieterse Museum, Mandela House and Regina Mundi before you leave the commercial hub and travel into the Mpumalanga region. Continue through Graskop to Hazyview, just outside Kruger National Park. Dinner will be included in your hotel this evening.

DAY 4: SUN KRUGER NATIONAL PARK (B/-/D)

The world-renowned Kruger National Park offers a wildlife experience ranking among the best in Africa. There are approximately 147 mammal species here, including "The Big 5": lions, elephants, buffalos, leopards, and rhinos (black and white). Spend your day searching for animals from the comfort of your coach as you explore the 20,000 square kilometer park. You might be lucky and spot Africa's 'Big Five' — experience the exhilarating feeling of seeing wildlife from a close range! This is a truly unforgettable experience. Dinner will be included at your hotel in the evening.

Overnight in Kruger National Park Area

Note: For the full-day game drive, guests will take a coach for about 45 minutes to get from the Radisson Safari Hotel to Orpen Gate.

Optional: Upgrade to an Open Vehicle Safari – \$100 per person

A safari in an open vehicle through Kruger National Park is not to be taken lightly! This is a great privilege beyond imagination. As one of the world's

most famous game reserves is not only vast with a fascinating range of wildlife and birdlife but is also renowned for its ever-changing African landscapes! For photographers, this is a dream destination, with no less than 147 mammals and over 500 species of birds waiting for the click of your camera. DAY 5: MON JOHANNESBURG – CAPE TOWN – STELLENBOSCH (B/-/-)

This morning you will travel back to Johannesburg and board a flight from OR Tambo International Airport to Cape Town. Upon arrival at Cape Town International Airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel in Stellenbosch. Spend the rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 6: TUE STELLENBOSCH (B/-/-)

After breakfast at the hotel, you will proceed on the following Winelands tour.

Full Day Winelands Tour

South Africa's fertile valleys are famous for their crisp white and classic French-style red wines. The area is also a treasury of rustic beauty and sprawling estates shaded by giant oak trees. On this tour, you may visit the country's principal wine routes of Paarl, Stellenbosch, and Franschhoek. Two wine tastings will be included along with one cellar tour.

DAY 7: WED STELLENBOSCH – CAPE TOWN (B/-/-)

After breakfast, you will drive back to Cape Town to enjoy a half-day orientation tour of the city. You will see iconic buildings, snatches of history, and experience the uniqueness of the city. Drive past the country's oldest building, the Castle, and a short distance away, the Company Gardens, both historically fascinating and well conserved. Our drive will continue past the Parliament Buildings, City Hall, and the Slave Lodge. You will sense the depth of history via their distinctive architecture. Colonial will change to colourful, as you move up the cobblestoned hills to the Malay Quarter, and marvel over the ice-cream colors of the quaint Bo-Kaap homes. Before returning to the hotel visit the breathtaking Table Mountain. Later if the weather is suitable, you may participate in the Robben Island optional tours below.

Table Mountain Cable Car Ticket

With your ticket, take a cable car up to the summit of the legendary Table Mountain from where you may see the end of the world, including the city and surrounding layout of this southernmost tip of Africa.

Overnight in Cape Town

Optional: Robben Island Boat Ticket– \$85 per person

Board your boat cruise at the Waterfront and head towards the famous Robben Island. A cruel home of our Nelson Mandela for so many years, this is a highly charged emotional visit as you visit this site of suffering and realize how far South Africa has come since those days. For nearly 400 years, Robben Island, about 12 kilometers from Cape Town, was a place of exile and imprisonment where rulers sent those who they considered being outcasts and troublemakers. Since 1997, Robben Island has been a museum acting as a focal point of South African heritage.

DAY 8: THU CAPE TOWN (B/-/D)

After breakfast you will proceed on the following full-day Peninsula Tour. In the evening, get ready for your farewell dinner at the Gold Restaurant with an Interactive drumming activity.

Full Day Cape Peninsula Tour

On this full-day tour, you will be able to explore the dramatic coastline of the Cape Peninsula, including a visit to the Boulders Beach penguin colony and Cape Point Nature Reserve (entrance fees not included). Summer tours will also visit Kirstenbosch, a famous and beautiful botanical garden at the foot of Table Mountain; while tours in the winter will visit Groot Constantia, a historical wine estate founded in 1685.

Overnight in Cape Town

DAY 9: FRI CAPE TOWN – LOS ANGELES (B/-/-)

Spend your morning at leisure. This afternoon you will be transferred to Cape Town International Airport for your overnight flight home.
