Visitors to Vietnam are overwhelmed by the sublime beauty of the country's natural setting: the Red River Delta in the north, the Mekong Delta in the south and almost the entire coastal strip are a patchwork of brilliant green rice paddies tended by women in conical hats. Experience the divine beaches, soaring mountains, some of which are cloaked by dense, misty forests. Vietnam also offers an opportunity to see a country of traditional charm and rare beauty rapidly opening up to the outside world. Then discover Cambodia's ancient mystic temples, empty beaches, mighty rivers, remote forests colonial architecture all of which makes an attractive backdrop to bustling street-side cafes and the redeveloped riverfront

Included Features:

- Round trip air transportation from Los Angeles (LAX). Fuel surcharges and airport taxes are included. (valid at time of printing)
- Domestic air transportation between Hanoi to Saigon, Saigon to Siem Reap.

ITINERARY

April 21, 2017 – U.S.A.: Depart from U.S.A. for your flight to Vietnam.

April 23, 2017 - Hanoi: On arrival in Hanoi you will be met by our representative and transferred to your hotel.

April 24, 2017 – Hanoi: After breakfast at the hotel depart for full day city tour. Vietnam's capital is a laid back city with charming French-Colonial style buildings, spacious boulevards and bustling markets. Today's included tour takes in the city's highlights including: Ho Chi Minh Complex (Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, and stilt house, One Pillar Pagoda), Temple of Literature, Hoan Kiem Lake, fascinating network of alleyways and shop-houses in the Old Quarter. Lunch is at the local restaurant. Later this afternoon, transferred to the theatre where the ancient and unique art form of water puppetry is enacted. Welcome dinner is at the local restaurant. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

April 25, 2017 – Hanoi / Halong / Hanoi: After breakfast at the hotel depart for full day tour of Halong. Start out early this morning on an overland drive to Halong Bay. Upon arrival, enjoy a peaceful cruise onboard a traditional junk on the Bay, stopping at some of the grottoes and caves on the islands to explore on foot. Seafood set lunch will be served onboard. Disembark the boat in the afternoon then return to Ha Noi in early evening and transfer to your hotel. (Breakfast, Lunch)

April 26, 2017 – Hanoi / Saigon: After breakfast at the hotel transfer to airport for your flight to Saigon. Upon arrival enjoy half day city tour. Also known as Ho Chi Minh City, Saigon is Vietnam's largest and most vibrant city, packed with timeless traditions, the beauty of an ancient culture, fantastic architecture, bustling markets and a modern business district. Today's included sightseeing tour takes in Dong Khoi Street, the main shopping thoroughfare, the Notre Dame Cathedral and the Central Post Office. Afterwards visit the Reunification Palace, the War Remnants Museum, as well as Cholon, the Chinese district. (Breakfast)

April 27, 2017 – Saigon: After breakfast at the hotel free day at leisure. You can explore the Saigon on your own or you can take an optional tour of Cu Chi Tunnels or Mekong Delta. (Breakfast)

April 28, 2017 – Saigon / Siem Reap: After breakfast transfer to airport for your flight to Siem Reap. Arrival at Siem Reap International Airport, welcome and transfer to your hotel for freshen up. Pre-dinner cocktails at FCC restaurant Welcome dinner at Malis Restaurant or similar in Siem Reap, where you will enjoy the real taste of Khmer food. (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 29, 2017 - Siem Reap: After breakfast at the hotel depart for full day city tour. This morning, depart by Romork visit the monumental magnificence of Angkor Thom - last capital of the Khmers; we begin our visit at the Terrace of the Leper King and Phimeanakas, whose name means "Heavenly Palace". This intricately carved platform was the royal crematorium and the statue that was originally thought to be the leper king is now believed to be Yama, the god of death. We continue along the Terrace of Elephants, originally used as a viewing gallery for the king to preside over parades, performances and traditional sports. At the southern end lies the Baphuon, once of the most beautiful temples at Angkor, dating from the reign of Uditayavarman 1 in the 11th century. It has undergone a massive renovation by the French and is now once again open for viewing. Our climax is the enigmatic and enchanting temple of the Bayon. This 12th century masterpiece lies at the very centre of Angkor Thom and is an archaeological wonder of symmetry and grandeur. The exterior gallery walls have extensive bas-reliefs but the highlight is the "faces", more than 200 of them, silent but with the famous half-smile playing on their lips. PJ de Beerski wrote of them; "godliness in the majesty and the size, mystery in the expression." Continue to visit Ta Prohm, the temple that has been left largely in its natural state since its "re-discovery" by French explorers. Surrounded by jungle, its labyrinth of stone hallways is overgrown with the roots and limbs of massive banyan trees, which envelop the stone like tentacles. It is one of the largest temples at Angkor, dedicated in 1186. Historians have noted its mystical charm. Lunch at Angkor Café restaurant Then, visit of Angkor Wat temple, the largest temple in the world, with a volume of stone equaling that of the Cheops pyramid in Egypt. It is unlike all the other Khmer temples in that it faces west, and is inspired by 12th Century Hinduism. Its symmetrical towers are stylized on the modern Cambodian flag. Conceived by Survavarman II, Angkor Wat took an estimated 30 years to build. It is generally believed to have been a funeral temple for the king. It has been occupied continuously by Buddhist monks and is well preserved. Intricate bas-reliefs surround Angkor Wat on four sides. Each tells a story. The most celebrated of these is the Churning of the Ocean of Milk, which is located on the east wing. In it the Naga serpent, is twisted by demons and gods to spurt out the elixir of life. Enjoy the sunset from Angkor Wat. (Breakfast, Lunch)

April 30, 2017 – Siem Reap: After breakfast at the hotel, full day at your leisure. Late afternoon, our tour guide will pick you up from hotel to enjoy the dinner with show at local restaurant as the farewell dinner. (Breakfast, Dinner)

May 1, 2017– Departure: After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to airport for your flight back home. You will arrive in U.S.A. on the May 2, 2017.(Breakfast)
